# ARA President's report 2013-2017

I would like to start by recognizing the dedication and the contribution of the large majority of members who are dedicated to the mission of ARA academy and support and promote the Romanian intellectual elite in the world.

At the last year's annual meeting, we celebrated the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ARA Congress. The ARA Congress is the only academic activity that truly sets up the foundation of friendships and holds us together as an organization. It also increases the cultural and spiritual relations between the Diaspora members in the United States and members in Romania.

ARA's beginnings are traced back to 1975. From George Ciorănescu's call to action: "Do something, do not stay with your hands crossed and unfocused! For our Romania!", the Romanian intellectuals in exile residing in USA established an association, becoming the American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences. Furthermore, it called out to Romanian intellectuals from America and other countries to which foreign intellectuals adhered with love for Romania, Romanian culture, and science. This organization has become a small academy of liberal spirits and an island of effervescent thoughts, a crucible of many works that have seen the light of the printing, thus approaching all manifestations of the Romanian spirit, but keeping the accents of our native country. Every year, ARA organizes a Congress that provides an open forum for intellectuals to present their ideas and achievements in the fields of literature, philosophy, medicine, social sciences, arts, engineering, mathematics, physics, and chemistry etc. Thus, the American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences has in time become the largest Romanian academic organization of culture, arts and sciences outside Romania.

As an elected President of ARA in 2013 I did my best as the incoming president to establish and develop the priorities of ARA as an academy, and these aspects will be outlined in this report. However, there are other activities that pertain to how the outside world perceives us and where we position ourselves in contrast to other academies. These activities are not seen per se, but we have devoted them a great deal of time because I assumed a responsibility when I accepted to be the President, and wanted to respect it while getting my mandate done out of respect for me and for you, the members of ARA.

In the followings, the main activities of the Leadership team are presented.

#### 1. Legal Status and California Compliance





Figure 1. Excerpt of the original Articles of Incorporation of the ARA Academy (1975).

**1.1 Incorporation:** ARA was incorporated in 1975 in California as a nonprofit corporation (see Figure 1). Since not all the nonprofit corporations are tax-exempt, ARA obtained a 501(c)(3) nonprofit status and became a federally tax-exempt charity that does not pay income or sales tax, and allows US donors to write off contributions. Therefore, ARA is a nonprofit corporation but also a nonprofit organization from the IRS point of view.

- 1.2. California Law: ARA is organized in conformity with the California laws and regulations (the state of incorporation) and has several compliances that were annually reported. I found out that the former Treasurer has neglected his duties, but more disturbing, he ignored the compliances related to the State of California Department of Justice, Office of the Attorney General. Because he didn't file the requested documentation with the California Attorney General for 3 years, ARA's nonprofit status was suspended. I was able to restore the ARA nonprofit status in December 2015. Since then, ARA didn't have any other delinquencies.
- **1.3. ARA Logo**: The new ARA logo was re-designed (Figure 2) by George Roca, ARA Emeritus Member, to include the word "ARA" as a text. The ARA logo is unique so it cannot be used by other organizations or individuals than ARA Leadership team.

Having a current and up-to-date website provides several strategic purposes for ARA as follows:


- display and promote the ARA logo

- promote ARA's activities



#### 3. ARA MEMBERSHIP

ARA members are already making an impact in the U.S., Romania and globally. This is why it is so important to be an Academy of the highest standing and excellence. Becoming an Academy was an achievement decade in the making. It reflects the great professional distinction of our members and their significant contributions to arts and sciences. Today, I would like to take time to recognize and celebrate our members all over the world.

## 3.1. Elected ARA Members

As you know, Full and Corresponding Members of ARA are elected by their peers in recognition of outstanding achievements. Our members have made breakthrough discoveries, they are professors, members of the Romanian Academy, the Academy of Romanian Scientists and the Academy of Medical Sciences etc and researchers at the cutting edge of major scientific breakthroughs who brought contributions that have advanced life for all of us, they are internationally recognized artists, architects, musicians that committed to advance the mission of ARA. They truly represent the best and the brightest of Romanian origin.

During the past 4 years, ARA elected 59 new members (Table 1) out of which 50 Full Members and 9 Corresponding Members, and 2 Honorary members: Prof. Stefan Hell and Prof. Dan Fornade.

Table 2 presents the number of elected ARA Full and Corresponding Members per year. The election procedure is a laborious process that involves discussions with the ARA members

to nominate new members, discussions with the potential members, nomination, preparation of the documentation for the ballot, prepare the vote and sending out the ballot, the vote, the election, and the announcement of the election.

It can be seen in Table 2 that in the first year, 26 personalities were selected and nominated to become ARA members. This is because I had more time to dedicate to the real academic mission of ARA, compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> year,

## 3.2. ARA Membership composition

An analysis of the composition of ARA members performed in 2013 revealed that the ratio between Corresponding to Full members was 69.72%, which was much higher than the 50% ratio imposed by ARA Bylaws. This meant that for the next few years, the number of the elected Full members had to be much higher than the elected Corresponding members.




Figure 3. Charts of the ARA membership composition in 2017 vs 2013.

Figure 3 shows the composition of ARA members in 2013 in comparison to 2017. In the past four years, the increase in the number of Full members resulted in a correction of the membership balance and a ratio of 53.46% was achieved.




Figure 4. The evolution of ARA income from membership during 2008-2017 (note: the income for 2014, 2015 and 2016 are estimated from the data available to us.

The increase in the number of elected ARA members had a striking impact on the income of ARA coming from membership, as illustrated in Figure 4. Compared to 2013, an increase of 42.75 % and 71.90 % were observed for 2016 and 2017, respectively.

However, the income from membership is much smaller than that expected from the total number of members. For example, a brief analysis of the income from membership for 2015 (Table ) shows that the total income for ARA from membership should be \$17,300. According to Figure 4, the actual income was \$4104, i.e. only 23.72% of the total income.




Figure 5. Illustration showing income values from membership from two MS Excel worksheets presented by Dinu Leonte on October 14, 2015

However, during the time when Dinu Lente was ARA Treasurer, the financial information that he presented to the Board was very uncertain, the amount of the income from membership changing literary from one page to another. Figure 5 show an example of two pages taken from Dinu Leonte's financial report, were the amount of income from membership varies from \$4,104 to \$4,396. Which value is correct? We do not know because he refused to present us with any kind of records showing either the source of the money or the receipts that he was supposed to give to members.

## 3.3. ARA membership geographical spreading




Figure 6. Chart representing the number of Full and Corresponding members in each country.

As of today, ARA has 290 members including non-active and/or dead. Geographical spreading of ARA membership and the number of members per the 15 countries (Figure 6).

Recent achievements of our members are highlighted in the ARA Newsletter that we have just re-started last year, after 16-years absence.

Each member should have a link to a webpage he/she owns, or a short presentation of his/her activity, which should be updated constantly.

#### 4. Bylaws

John F. Kennedy once said, "Time and the world do not stand still. Change is the law of life." This is so true especially for ARA's Bylaws that used for 40 years a terminology that became obsolete and gave rise to speculations and misinterpretations when compared to the California Corporate Code.

The ARA bylaws has been long overdue for a structural overhaul as it has not been revised in 40 years. As a nonprofit organization that was legally formed as a nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation under California state law, **ARA bylaws needed to be restructured to comply with the current California Corporations Code**. The Amendments to the ARA bylaws have been presented to ARA members one month before the 40<sup>th</sup> Congress, and then discussed, explained and agreed in 2017 General Assembly. The amendments to ARA bylaws follows the standard bylaws of a current nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation under California state law.

One prominent change is related to the ARA governance structure terminology, where the ARA governing bodies were renamed according to the California rules, i.e. the **ARA governing** body called Executive Committee changed the name to Board of Directors. Similarly, the names of committees have changed to improve the activities of the ARA organization. Changes to ARA's status were approved by majority vote on September 21, 2016.

#### 5. Publications

Historically, ARA publications consisted of books, ARA Journal (1977-2004), ARA Congress Proceedings (2000-prezent), Libertas Mathematica (1981-2000), Libertas Mathematica new series (2012-present).

ARA Publications were published under the ARA Academy, but the publications were published by various publishing houses and there was no publication inventory were kept at people's garages. In 2014, leveraging on my expertise as a publisher in the United States working with major Publishing Houses, I organized the ARA Publisher as the first Publishing House of the ARA Academy. and signed a contract with a major printing company. The printing company offers a wide range of advantages including world-wide exposure through online retailers such as *Amazon* and *Barn and Nobles*, and there is no need to carry inventory. In this way, I was able to align the ARA Academy to a modern and dynamic editorial services that would benefit our partners and collaborators from the Romanian Academy, the Academy of Romanian Scientists and the Academy of Medical Sciences. Also, the ARA Publisher make available to everyone, worldwide, our publications through the online retailers, eliminating ARA's dependence on someone's garage space.

5.1 ARA Journal: started as the main publication of ARA in 1977, to publish papers presented at the ARA Congress. In 2004 the last issue of ARA Journal was published and my understanding is that it was replaced with the ARA Congress Proceedings. This is because while the ARA Journal would publish the papers after there were presented at a Congress, ARA Congress Proceedings was published before the Congress. These are only my observations, because no one could tell me why the

publication of the ARA Journal was interrupted in 2004. The ARA Journal will be restarted if members so request.

**5.2.** ARA Congress Proceedings. For the past for years, the ARA Congress Proceedings have been published using the new digital print-on-demand system that offers a multitude of ways to increase the bottom line through smarter inventory management and more capable services; to meet customer demand without overprinting, take control of printing costs, increase ARA's market exposure through more than 39,000 retailers, libraries, and other points of sale, improve inventory control and significantly reduce overhead by eliminating warehousing costs, access to the world's largest book distribution network of wholesalers, retailers, and book sellers.

The following ARA Congress Proceedings have been published using mostly volunteers to format, edit and prepare the book for publication. The 2015 and 2016 pictures used on the front cover of the proceedings were the images of painting donations. I want to use this opportunity to thank very much to Alexandru Darida, Luminita Gliga, Carmen Doreal si Mihai Teodor Olteanu for their kind donations.

Also, the papers presented at the ARA Congresses in the past 3 years received an unique DOI number and published online in an open source. The open source system allows for papers to have maximum exposer and to be cited.




All the books we published through ARA Publisher are available online through Amazon and Barns and Noble. Regarding Amazon, I was able to provide also my expertise in econversion, so that the books are available in Kindle format (a system that allows readers to read books on electronic devices).

#### 6. ARA DIGITAL LIBRARY

This is a premier for ARA, which will increase tremendously the visibility of ARA in the international academic community. Since the whole ARA archive of documents and over 6,000 books, ARA Journals, has been lost due to Oana and Dinu Leonte, I lunched last year a daring initiative called "ARA Digital Library" with the key goal to restore ARA history. This initiative started to gain support from ARA members and non-members. This initiative focusses on identifying the ARA publications, press releases and media presence, for the past 40+ years.

ARA books have been scanned, converted to editable document and then re-edited in a new format. The books were published as a second edition with a new cover. All the work has been done voluntarily by ARA members and didn't cost ARA any money. See a couple of books that were digitalized or in the digitalization process.



In 1990, at the 85-year-old anniversary of Ionel Jianu, American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences has published his book "Un om, or viaţă, un destin, Ionel Jianu şi opera lui". The book was presented at the ARA Congress in Montreal. The book written by Ionel Jianu is the first edition published under the ARA's auspices at the Mircea Eliade Research Institute and includes short stories and essays on Jianu's work and friends such as Petru Comarnescu, Mircea Eliade, Constantin Noica etc.

#### 7. ARA NEWSLETTER

In 2016, the ARA Newsletter was restarted. For years, the Editorial board of ARA newsletter was led by Prof. Aleksandra Gruzinska. Last year, I proposed a new digital format for the ARA Newsletter, a modern new layout, which gives ARA the ability to upload and distribute the newsletter worldwide.



## 8. ARA HEADQUARTER EXPENSES

Table shows the expenses occurred during the past 4 years. All the expenses were supported with my own money. All the expenses are well-documented and supported by receipts, according to the United States accounting practices. Starting 2014, Dinu Leonte, the former Treasurer, has refused to reimburse me for the ARA expenses invoking various reasons, some of which were lies and the other were pure speculations and interpretations. It went so far to accuse me to having him removed from the Treasurer position so I could get access the ARA money and get my hands on the money!

As of today, **I was not reimbursed for the expenses incurred with the ARA expenses** in the four-year term of presidency. The following table shows the ARA Office expenses incurred in the last 4 years.

On April 4, 2016, I was invited to the celebration of 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Romanian Academy. The American Romanian Academy's presence at the event solidified the relationship between the two organizations and strengthened ties between the Romanian and American academies. The Romanian Academy recognized that all organizations abroad, such as the American Romanian Academy, are doing to promote academic excellence within the Diaspora. The event was attended

The American Romanian Academy continues to foster relationships with prestigious organizations abroad, sustaining the tradition of intellectual development and academic progress, being an inspiration for the younger generation.

#### 10. CONCLUSIONS
